

STUDENTS: WHAT DO I DO?

IF YOU WERE EXPOSED TO COVID-19

Regardless of vaccination status, you must **monitor for symptoms** for at least 5 days. There is no need to quarantine if no symptoms are present.

Seek a **COVID-19 test**.

The CDC recommends continue monitoring for symptoms and wearing a mask for **10 days**.

IF YOU HAVE SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19

Monitor yourself for worsening symptoms, including fever.

Seek a **COVID-19 test**.

You **must** contact and work with your instructor to ensure all coursework is completed in a timely manner.

IF YOU HAVE A POSITIVE COVID-19 TEST RESULT

Regardless of vaccination status, you may return to class if symptoms are improving and no fever for 24 hours.

Contact your **doctor** or call the **Olin Health Center** if your symptoms worsen.

If COVID negative, return to normal activities after you are feeling better. If COVID positive, return to normal activities if symptoms improve and no fever for 24 hours.
